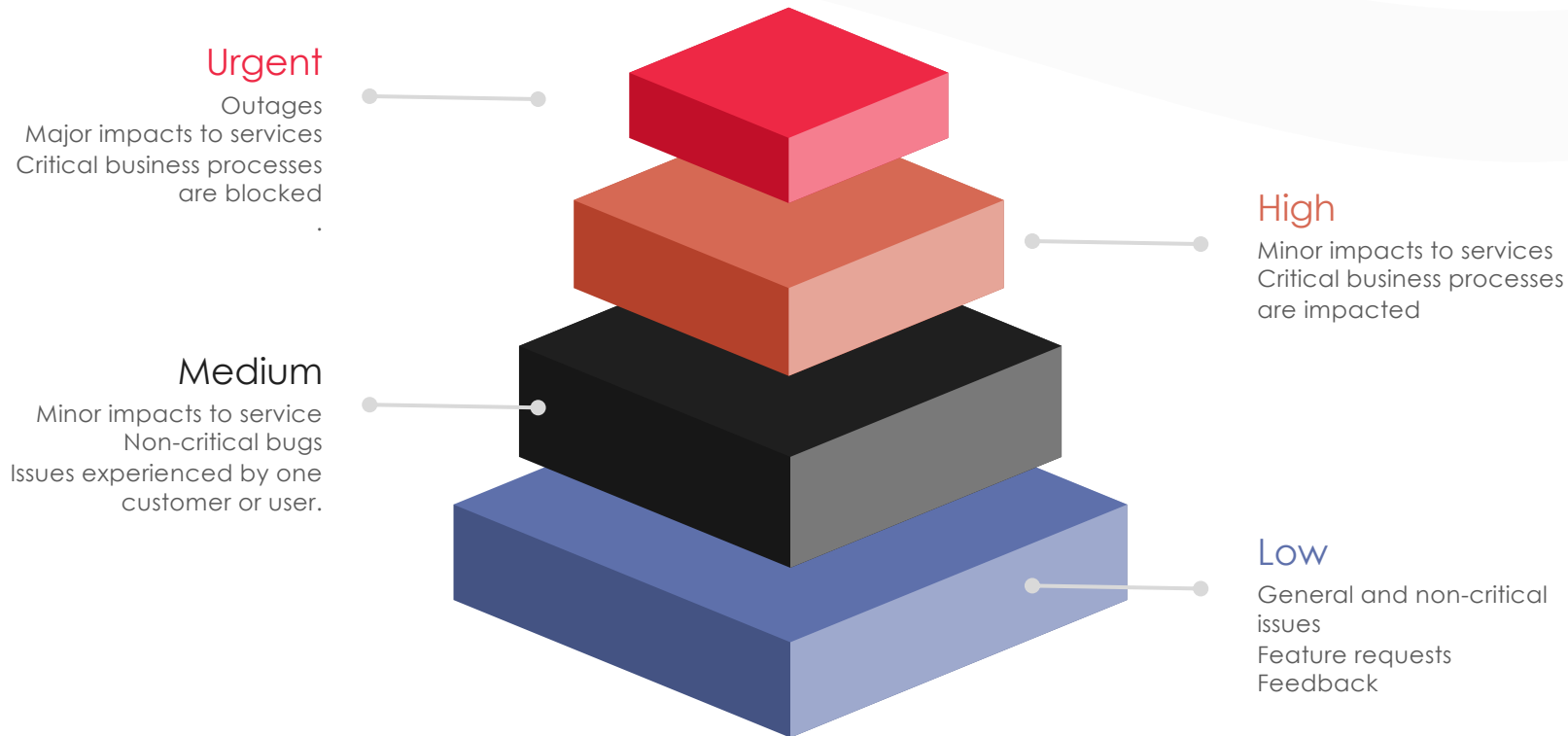

New Setting: Date Display when Creating Files

- Added a setting, **Show Dates Per Controlling Body**, to control the display of agenda dates when creating a new file, if the **Restrict Agenda Date Selection** setting is on.
- If the **Show Dates Per Controlling Body** setting is set to **Yes**, Legistar only shows dates belonging to the same body as the file. If the setting is **No**, Legistar behaves as it previously has, showing the primary legislative body in dark green and others in light green.

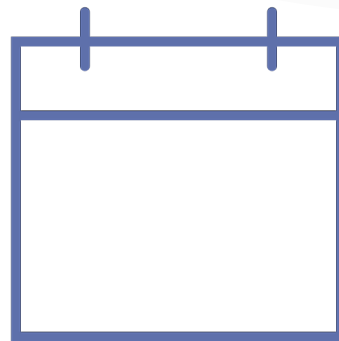

New Setting: Show Agenda Dates on Home Screen

- Added a new setting in Administration, **General | Approvals Show Agenda Dates On Home Screen**, which is optional if a jurisdiction wishes to see the agenda data for a file in the Approval Requests list on the Home page.
- By default, the setting is disabled and approvals are displayed as before.

New Setting: Cover Page Generation Preference

- We have added a new setting in Administration, **Legislative Files | Show Cover Per Each Legislative Item**. By default, this setting is set to **No**. When set to **Yes**, the setting only enables the checkbox on the **Details** tab; a user must still mark each file individually if they want to skip generating a cover for that item.
- This feature is for Agenda/Minutes packets only; it does not affect Legislative Files packets. other.

Security Improvement

- We have applied code signing to files used by Legistar as a security best practice.
- This change applies a digital signature to software files or binaries to validate the identify of the software author and verify that the file has not been altered or tampered with since signing.
- This change does not impact the functionality of Legistar; it simply offers additional assurance that these files are verified by Granicus.

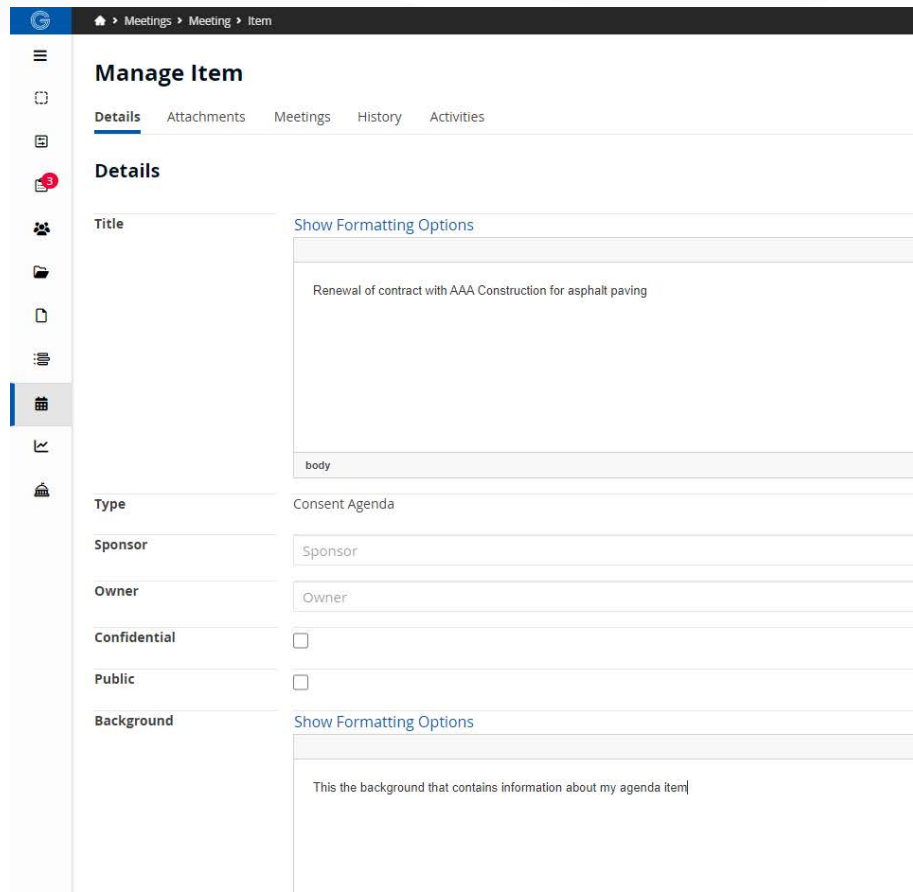
API Updates

- Added a new parameter, **OfficeRecordExtraText**, to the [https://webapi.legistar.com/v1/\[ClientName\]/officerecords](https://webapi.legistar.com/v1/[ClientName]/officerecords) endpoint. This value comes from the Legistar Office Records view in admin.
- We have updated the Legistar API to make the **OfficeRecordSupportNameID** field (**Appointed By** in the UI) updatable using PUT and POST.
- We have made a small change to API documentation to indicate that the Legistar API uses the more secure HTTPS protocol rather than HTTP.

Description
The City Council is the governing body of the City of Gilroy. It consists of seven (7) members comprised of a Mayor and six (6) Council Members who are elected at-large and do not represent specific districts, but rather represent all members of the community as a whole. The Mayor and the City Council hold office for four (4) year terms with no term limits. The City Council meets the first and third Monday of each month in addition to special meetings, which are called throughout the year. Elections are held in even-numbered years, with three (3) Council Members elected in one cycle (Governatorial Elections), and three (3) Council Members and Mayor elected in the alternate cycle (Presidential Elections).

In accordance with California Government Code Section 36502 (a), a person is not eligible to hold office as a council member unless they are, at the time of assuming the office, an elector of the city, and are a registered voter of the city at the time nomination papers are issued to the candidate as provided for in Section 10227 of the California Elections Code. If, during their term of office, they move to a place of residence outside of the city limits or cease to be an elector of the city, their office shall immediately become vacant.

All powers of the City and the determination of all matters of policy are vested in the City Council, subject to provisions in the City Charter and the Constitution of the State of California. The full text of Gilroy's City Charter and Municipal Code is available at www.cityofgilroy.org.
